Installer MUST apply weatherproof silicone sealant (NOT included) at ALL potential water entry points to meet the NEC Code requirement for a sealed waterproof raceway system. This is especially important for uneven wall surfaces.







## SEAL ALL POTENTIAL WATER ENTRY POINTS:


- Perimeter of fixture housing at wall
- Surfaces between fixture and gaskets
- Surfaces between gaskets/fixtures and recessed junction boxes
- Surfaces between fixture mounting plates and wall
- Threaded couplings installed into housing
- Wiring entrance points
- Mounting holes and mounting hardware
- Any unused mounting holes
- Any opened and reinstalled coin plugs







